By commissioning a piece from me, you're agreeing by the next terms of service (now on referred as TOS) listed bellow:

Any statement made here can be bound to change/altered if discussed with the artist (me) before making the commission

General Commission terms:

- Please write in a polite and understandable manner
- If possible, provide already existing depictions of the situation/character/thing you want commissioned. References are a must or either a well detailed description.
- Specify if the commission will be SFW or NSFW, but, by any means, you must be 18 or older to commission me. If I get to know that you're under that age, the commission will be immediately canceled with no chance to get a refund.

Payment:

- Payment method will be through Paypal, and using USD only
- I'll only be taking full price upfront payments unless talked with me prior to commissioning about the payment form.

Commission Process:

- Work in Progress pictures (WIP from now on) will be given on a regular (from 5-7 days) basis to keep the client updated on the progress as long as their commission is the next in line.
- The minimum time a commission will take to do it is at least a
 week, and the maximum time is 2 months if everything goes
 smoothly, yet this is bound to change if any sort of problem
 surges, which will be communicated as soon as possible to the
 client.
 - About commission changes:
 - When the commission is being made, several WIP will be sended, which are the points where changes can be made
 .WIP stages being, in order: 1-Composition sketch

2- Raw poses

3- Raw sketch
4- Detailed sketch
5- Final sketch
6- Lineart
7- Base coloring
8- Shading and lighting
9- Effects and additional details
10- Final piece

Minor changes will only be applied from the detailed sketch phase from then on (such as details that can be changed, like earrings or any other small thing).

- Major changes are going to be charged an extra, depending on how big this change is, it will cost more or less.
- The commission's way to be delivered will depend on the final PNG file size. The commissioner's email may be asked for.

Copyright / Usage policy

I, the artist, hold every right to the drawn piece, not the commissioner.

Therefore, unless made private commissioning I:

- Can use the piece to promote myself in any site/portfolio/place
 - Publish books with it
 - Display it anywhere to my liking
 - Post it wherever I want

The customer is allowed to:

- Use the copyrighted artwork for personal use only unless agreed otherwise.
- Print the art, and claim the right of their character(s) but not the drawing itself.
- Use the art to promote themselves with proper credit given to the artist.

If you break the copyright infringement in any way, every right you had to the drawing will be retracted.

The next actions are considered Infringement to this TOS's Copyright Policy:

- Reproducing/using the copyrighted artwork commercially. (Meaning making money of it in any way)
 - Taking Credit for the creation of the artwork.
 - Removing any watermarks/signatures.
 - Altering the artwork without my, the artist's, consent.

A Purchase of Commercial rights to the artwork will always be 300% of original price.

With commercial rights you are allowed to make any sort of merchandise with the artwork.

Use it in books, covers, as Props, change it to your liking and promote your own brand with.

Credit is still required for usage of the artwork, even if altered or edited.

Canceling / Refunding policy

You do have the right to cancel your commission whenever it is still in the sketch phases, but only aspiring to get a 40% back of the original commission price in case you decide to go with the full price upfront.

If a chargeback against me is filed, the rights that you have to everything I have made for you will be retracted and I will forbid you to commission me, Red Angel, ever again. I will post your name publicly to watch out for you.

I also have every right to file a complaint and I have all the right to the money you have given me.
